MINUTES ON ARRIVAL TO

Mr Smith
45 years old
PMHX – Well
Collapse at supermarket /
failed AED, and 4 shocks /
LUCAS applied

Progress:

Time of arrest 0:00, witnessed, bystander CPR

Ambulance arrival 0:07, effective CPR witnessed, no AED

Attache pades 0:09 - shock x1

ALS management x 3 COACHed, adrenaline

LUCAS deployed 15 mins

Leave scene 23 mins

Expected arrival 35 mins post arrest

Handover for radio and in person:

RADIO CALL - Start by calling bat phone on 02 88907550, then radio

Start with "exercise, exercise, exercise"

This is car XXX coming to you with:


45 year old male patient in CARDIAC ARREST. He is a potential RESET study patient.

SIM ECMO

Roles Cards and Positions

ED ALS TEAM

Medical Team leader (ED Specialist or Fellow)

Suggested Roles:

- Remain Hands off
- Work with Nurse T/L
- Allocate Roles
- Drive Resuscitation in terms of Disposition/Diagnosis

ED ALS TEAM

Airway Doctor (ED Specialist or Reg)

Suggested Roles:

- Hands on, (?PPE prn)
- Primary Survey
- Work with ED Nurses
- Intubate
- Tie Tube
- Connect to EtCO2
- Ventilator Mx

ED ALS TEAM

Circulation Doctor (ED Specialist or Reg)

Suggested Roles:

- Stand right side of room
- Large IV line and VBG
- Radial Arterial Line
- Left IJ central line as required by ECMO team
- Ask T/L for role if above complete

ED ALS TEAM

Nursing Team leader

Suggested Roles:

- Remain Hands off
- Work with Medical T/L
- Allocate resources
- Drive Resuscitation in terms of logistics
- Keep noise down

ED ALS TEAM

Crowd Control Doctor

Suggested Roles:

- Remain Hands off
- Prevent Chaos
- Ensure safety of Team(s)
- Actively Prevent Noise from Observers/Outside
- Assist with Calls (cardio, ICU) numbers are PTO

ED ALS TEAM

Nursing Scout Nurse / Runner

Suggested Roles:

- Get non-ALS drugs ready
- Set up procedure trolleys outside room
- Get other equipment PRN
- Assist Nursing T/L and inside nurses with tasks

ED ALS TEAM

Nursing Airway

Suggested Roles:

- Flexible Role
- Work with Nurse T/L
- Provide Assistance with Airway as required
- ALS drugs
- Ask ECMO team when drugs are required

ED ALS TEAM

Nursing Defibrillation

Suggested Roles:

- Operate Defib / COACH
- Operate LUCAS
- Attach Monitoring
- Keep Time
- Connect Ventilator

PERFUSIONIST

Suggested Roles:

- Ensures pump primed and ready
- Passes lines once cannulation successful
- Manages ECMO

ECMO Cannulation (x2)

Suggested Roles:

- Apply STOP criteria checklist and decide to initiate ECMO
- Cannulate patient
- Instruct Perfusionist and Scrub RN
- Seek Resources from T/L

TOE Doctor

Suggested Roles:

- Source TOE from theatre
- Support airway team, ensure airway secure
- Assessment of:
 - LUCAS position
 - Assess causes (Dissection, Tamponade, Volume)
 - Catheter position

Scrub RN

Suggested Roles:

- Shave Groin
- Prep Groin
- Assists in Cannulation
- Assists Interventional Cardiologists PRN
- Ask T/L for further jobs
